DUBROVNIK WINTER FESTIVAL *30th November 2019 – 1st January 2020*

The City of Dubrovnik, the Dubrovnik Tourist Board and the Dubrovnik Summer Festival have prepared a rich cultural, entertainment, gastronomic and musical program for the sixth edition of the Dubrovnik Winter Festival, which begins on the 30th of November 2019 with the lighting of the first Advent candle and decorative holiday lighting, and ends on the 1st of January 2020. Experience the unique festive atmosphere of Dubrovnik with the sounds of the traditional "Christmas Carols" or "Kolenda" and enjoy the gastronomic offer of festive stands set in Dubrovnik's squares and streets.

A rich and varied program of events, with the jewel in the crown being the Dubrovnik Winter Festival, highlights all the traditions and customs of the wider Dubrovnik region.

WINTER SATURDAY MORNINGS IN THE CITY

The Dubrovnik Tourist Board organized the "Saturday Winter Mornings in the City" for the past six years. A free guided tour of the Old City will be organized every Saturday, from the 9th of November 2019 through until the 28th of March 2020 at 10am. After a tour of the Old City with a professional guide, the Dubrovnik Tourist Board presents a performance by the Lindo Folklore Ensemble, beginning at 11.30 am in front of the St. Blaise Church.

FESTIVITY OF ST. BLAISE *2nd to the 9th of February 2020*

White doves, banners, the relics of St. Blaise and a ceremonial procession mark the day of the patron saint of Dubrovnik, St. Blaise and the Day of the City of Dubrovnik on the streets of city. A series of secular and sacred events, from concerts, presentations, exhibitions and theatrical performances, are all dedicated to St. Blaise, who has been the patron saint of the city since 971.

OYSTER FESTIVAL

March 2020

Around St. Joseph's Day, the oysters from the Bay of Mali Ston, near Dubrovnik, are the most delicious. This ancient seafood, the food of noble people has its own aphrodisiac traits and carries with it many legends. The oyster festival in March on the Stradun has traditionally been organized by the Dubrovnik Tourist Board, with excellent wine from the Peljesac peninsula and the sounds of the vocal groups, or Klapa.
