The Dubelj Rural Family Homestead owns an old mill that is used for the production of olive oil. The mill is about 260 years old and olive oil is produced here in the old, traditional way, with a horse. The family has 180 olive trees and along with plenty of healthy and traditional food, olive oil tasting is an inevitable part of the offer of this homestead. The several hours spent at the Dubelj Rural Family Homestead will leave guests with unforgettable memories.

The blacksmith's trade has existed in Ljubač for nearly 150 years, while the house where the blacksmith is now located is somewhat newer.

Mainly horseshoes and various tools needed in agriculture and construction (hoes, cramps, carpentry and masonry tools, etc.) were made in the blacksmith's forge. Today, the blacksmith's forge is still in use, mostly for the repair of agricultural tools.

The process is as follows: the part being repaired is heated in the fire to the appropriate temperature and is moulded into the desired shape by a hammer. If necessary, the piece is reheated and reshaped again. Finally, small defects are filed down and the piece is cooled down in water.

Lovers of a more active enjoyment in nature can join the attractive walking program from Osojnik to Ljubač, accompanied by expert guides. The inspirational environment and the historic story of the French army that entered Dubrovnik using this road, which was the beginning of the end of the famed Dubrovnik Republic, the fresh air and the incredible view over the Bay of Zaton towards the Elaphite islands and Dubrovnik will certainly motivate those interested in walking around this interesting trail. The walk begins in Osojnik, a suburban village that was known as Asamon in Roman times, and will end in the rich fields of the Ljubač settlement, with rest and refreshments in the Country House Musladin.
