January

FESTA DUBROVNIK

This multi-day event traditionally marks the opening of the official programme of celebrations around the holiday of St. Blaise and the Day of the City of Dubrovnik. The programme features top Croatian performers, exhibitions, workshops, and tastings of regional wines.



February

THE FESTIVITY OF ST. BLAISE

Since 2009, the Feast of St. Blaise has been inscribed on UNESCO's List of Intangible Cultural Heritage. It is marked by Catholic religious ceremonies, traditional folklore and costumes, and a magnificent procession through the streets of the Old City, delighting both locals and international visitors year after year.



DUBROVNIK CARNIVAL

Although much of the programme is dedicated to children and young people, the long-standing tradition of celebrating the final day of Carnival with masked festivities—where individual and group costumes inspired by current political and social themes are eagerly anticipated—lives on and is enjoyed by all generations.



VALENTINE'S GOURMET DAYS

In February, Dubrovnik celebrates love with Valentine's Gourmet Days, featuring creative culinary experiences that combine tradition with contemporary flavours.



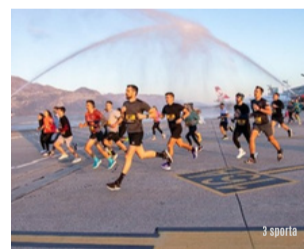
March
